Girls Inc. of Fort Smith Selection Guidelines

1. An applicant must have been a member of, or have given service to, Girls Inc. of Fort Smith for a minimum of two years (24 months, collectively). Higher consideration is given to girls who attended year round , i.e. after school and summer.
2. Arkansas residency is not required.
3. At minimum, applicants must be a senior in high school, however there is no maximum age limit.
4. A **unanimous recommendation** of the scholarship committee will make award of Girls Inc. scholarships.
5. An applicant must have a **minimum grade point average of 2.5** to apply for Girls Inc. scholarships.
6. Scholarship applications **MUST INCLUDE ALL REQUIRED ELEMENTS** or they will not be considered.
7. Any applicants who have previously received Girls Inc. of Fort Smith scholarships and wish to reapply must demonstrate to the scholarship selection committee's satisfaction that:
 - a. They are in good standing at the institution of higher learning in which they are enrolled.
 - b. They have completed sufficient coursework or training to be considered a regular, full-time student.
 - c. They have applied previous funding toward appropriate educational expenses.
8. The J.C. and June B. Alexander, Jr. Scholarship funds may be awarded to more than one applicant if the scholarship committee so chooses.
9. All scholarship recipients must be willing and able to volunteer for, or make appearances on behalf of Girls Inc. of Fort Smith as requested.
10. All scholarship applicants must be in good standing. Any unpaid balances must be paid before application will be considered.

Scholarship Application Required Elements:

1. Each applicant must submit a completed **typed** application.
2. Each applicant must submit a completed information sheet with all relevant questions answered thoroughly.
3. Each applicant *must* submit a current income tax return from parent or guardian.
4. An applicant must submit two **current** written recommendations from educational advisors, high school/college professors, counselors, principal, etc.
5. An applicant must submit a high school transcript (college transcript if applicant has attended college).
6. Each application must include a recent photo (it can be a photo copy).
7. Applicants will be interviewed in person by the scholarship committee. If an in person interview is not possible, we will do everything we can to make other arrangements.
